manna to the fathers sent.

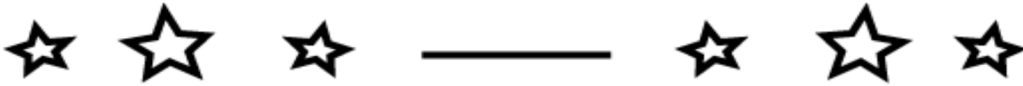
Very bread, good shepherd, tend us,

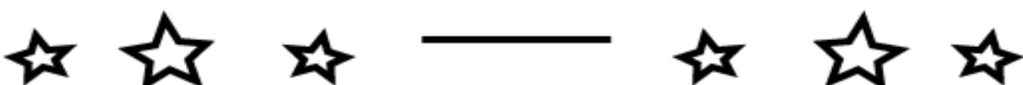
