Dear Friends!

Well the school year is upon us and we have solemnly begun this awesome year of catechetical renewal in our parish.

Remember, every Wednesday night is catechism night for our whole parish. **THIS INCLUDES ADULTS.** All adults, please come to the Church and be ready to go at 6:30pm sharp.

There is a long history of Wednesday catechism in the Church. St. John Vianney, the patron saint of parish priests, used to have a catechism lesson every Wednesday and we still have records of his teachings. Every Wednesday, our Holy Father the Pope also has a Wednesday general catechesis. Suffice it to say, it is definitely a traditional part of our Catholic heritage, coming on Wednesday to grow in our knowledge of God and our faith.

"My people perish for lack of knowledge" (Hosea 4:6). How many people leave the Church and how many souls are lost due to catechetical negligence, people not learning their faith and the WHYS behind what we do and believe. Well, now there is no excuse for such negligence. We have right here in our parish an excellent catechetical program for everyone, children and adults alike.

All you adults in the parish, please come on Wednesday nights. It is required of all parents who have children in CCD. But it is not only for them. We are starting this whole program of parish renewal which will bear tremendous and eternal fruits.

Every Wednesday night, from 6:30PM sharp to 7:20PM.

In addition to handing one out to all who come, the weekly syllabus will be printed here in the bulletin so you can keep up. It's seriously not much at all: only about 3-5 pages per week. That's totally manageable, folks, even among those with the busiest schedules!!! The book we will be using is the one-and-only, the greatest, the famous Baltimore Catechism. Everything you will need will be provided here by your parish here, free of charge.

Please, for the sake of your soul and all the souls that you will help by having mastered the material of our catechism, please don't miss this opportunity. Get someone you know to come too.

Finally, remember that in our CCD and RCIA and Confirmation programs if you have 4 unexcused absences, the whole year will have to be repeated. This mandatory attendance has already begun. So this is really the last chance to get your child(ren), friends and loved ones registered and coming.

God bless you! Please pray for our catechists and for all of us that we can continue to "grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and unto the day of eternity. Amen!"

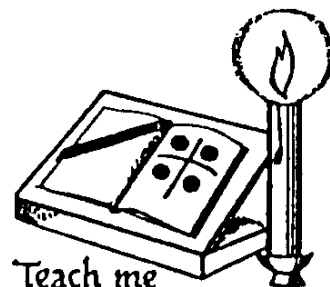
