Our parish is so full of life! And we have this week an especially wonderful week ahead of us!!! **Three (3) are the huge things happening:**

1) THE PARISH MISSION. Please plan to come. This is a really big deal and we have brought in a great presenter, Fr. Jewel Aytona, of the Fathers of Mercy, to lead our parish mission. He is a young, dynamic priest that you will love! Please come. Confessions start each night at 6PM and the mission presentation will begin at 7PM. The mission presentation will go about 50min to an hour.

The Mission starts this Sunday (Dec. 6th), and then goes each night on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Again, confessions start at 6PM and the mission presentation starts at 7PM.

2) A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION, THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, THIS TUESDAY, DECEMBER 8th. This is the patronal feast of our whole country! Mass attendance on this day is binding under pain of grave sin just as on Sundays. That means it should be every bit as crowded at the Masses on December 8th as it is on Sunday!

The Mass schedule will be as follows: We will have Mass at 7AM, Mass at 12:10PM and a solemn Mass at 5:30PM. We know that you have work or school, and so the Masses will be only 35 minutes at the 7AM and the 12:10PM Masses.

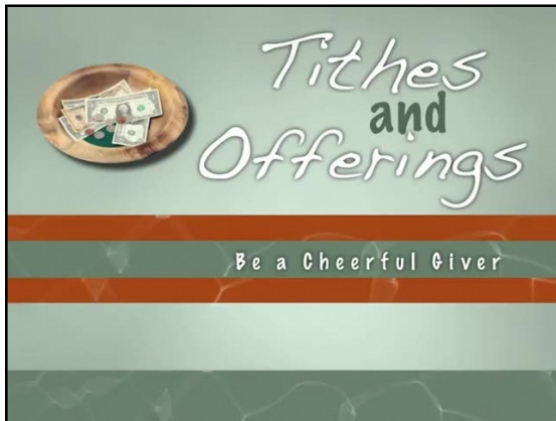
NEXT WEEKS GOSPEL READING
