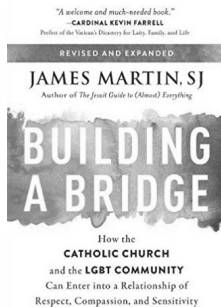

Archdiocese of Santa Fe Annual Catholic Appeal His Mercy Endures Forever...

Our Parish has to give \$37,000 to support the work of the whole archdiocese.

So far \$15,982 has been pledged and \$10,442 paid. Thank you to those who have given!!!

But this means our current shortfall is approximately \$21,018 which will come out of our Parish savings if people don't contribute.

Worst of all, of over 1,200 families in our Parish, so far only 60(!) families have participated or even pledged anything. That is not good and it reflects very poorly on us.
